IAD-YSTG 2019 promotes the participation of young researchers in the 6th Biennial Symposium of the International Society for River Science (ISRS) in Vienna, focussing on “*Riverine Landscapes as Coupled Socio-Ecological Systems*”.

Who is eligible:

PhD-students and young Postdocs (PhD defense from 1. January 2016 onwards) from countries of the Danube River Basin and/or IAD-members

How to apply:

Send e-mail to the **General Secretary of IAD** (Katrin.Teubner@univie.ac.at) not later than ~~15.4.2019~~ **4.June 2019 (new deadline)**, indicate in headline the subject “**IAD-YSTG 2019 Vienna**”

- pdf-file with abstract and indicate the submission for a concrete ISRS-session, note if it is submitted as an oral and/or poster presentation
- **short** statements in email text about the current carrier status as young researcher (in which year of PhD work or PostDoc, indicate the research framework, how it is linked to past or ongoing PhD grants from universities or other grants and/or research projects, provide websites if available)

Applications are assessed against the following criteria:

Scientific soundness of conference contribution & Early career status of young scientist
